## Ericsson EMAC Scholarship Awards

The Ericsson Emerging Media + Communication Scholarship awards a total of \$5000 for two students to use towards completing their final project for graduation. Awards will be given to the students who present the top final project idea to a faculty committee.

There are two awards:

\$2500 Ericsson Emerging Media **Undergraduate Award** criteria:

- Full time EMAC students in junior year present capstone ideas to committee of judges
- Students must be graduating and completing capstone during Spring 2011 semester
- Demonstrated high level of academic achievement with a GPA of 3.5 or better
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident

\$2500 Ericsson Emerging Media **Graduate Award** criteria:

- Highly-qualified students enrolled full time the Emerging Media + Communication MA Program
- Present project idea to committee of judges.
- Students must be graduating and completing capstone during Spring 2011 semester
- Open to all EMAC graduate students irrespective of citizenship or permanent residency status

### Details

Each of the \$2500 awards will be divided between a \$1,000 scholarship and \$1,500 toward purchase of equipment, software, wages for project support, etc. upon approval by faculty advisor.

**Presentations:** Each student will present to a faculty panel using a projector. Presenters may use any combination of presentation software, web sites, videos, images, etc they choose. Presentations will be strictly limited to four (4) minutes, with a Q&A by Faculty panel to follow. Students must present in order to be eligible for the scholarship.

Presentations will be held on Wednesday November 17 at 2 PM in the ATEC Conference Room and are open to the public. All interested students must submit an application by Friday,

November 5th, 2010.
